

# WGS course 'Preparing your Veni pre-proposal'

This programme aims to provide talented postdocs and other promising researchers the skills and competences needed to develop a high quality research pre-proposal to submit within the NWO Veni programme in the domains Social Sciences and Humanities (SSH) and Applied and Engineering Sciences (AES) and at the Netherlands Organisation for Health Research and Development (ZonMw).

NWO has rescheduled the deadline for submitting preproposals for the next Veni funding round (2021) in the domains SSH, AES and ZonMw from September 2020 to <u>January 2021</u>.

<u>What is this course</u>? A competence course to provide you with the skills needed to write a pre-proposal, tailored at the NWO Veni programme.

What this course is not? The course does not provide a complete tutorial leading to an application.
